Footnotes

SOLICITATION vied for the lead outside DYNAMIC DUKE to midway of the far turn, then drew away under pressure. PEGASUS HELLAS unhurried early, angled to the outside in the stretch and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. ALWAYSONTHEGOJOE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and gained the show while no threat to the winner. STARSHIP STORM rank under restraint while stalking the pace three wide, made a run to loom a threat approaching the quarter pole, then tired. DYNAMIC DUKE vied for the lead along the inside into the far turn and faltered. TOP PARTNER was not a factor. REJECT EVIL reserved while saving ground, drifted out on the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth. KAMINSKI was done early after being steadied when he broke in at the start and eased in the stretch run.
