TYLER'S WILDCAT reserved racing along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch LEFT WING WACKO at the sixteenth pole and edged away. LEFT WING WACKO stalked the pace off the rail, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner while holding the place. KRIS AND ME unhurried after being steadied in the early going, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and finished willingly for the show. CALPULLEC off slowly, outran BESSELINK around the first turn to gain the lead, made the pace along the inside into the stretch, then gave way. STRONG COMMITMENT broke slowly, then steadied to avoid running up on rivals racing into the first turn, stalked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and tired. BESSELINK showed brief speed and faded.
