SNAPPY TALE outrun early, angled out widest of all in the stretch and rallied to be just up at the wire. TUSCANY LIGHT vied for the lead along the inside, edged clear in midstretch, then bobbled at the gap leaving the sixteenth pole and just failed to last. DOC'S HONEY tracked the pace, eased outside TUSCANY LIGHT in the stretch and rallied to just miss. PIANO CHIMES unhurried early, closed with a belated rally in the drive. KATHY LEE G. reserved early, saved ground while advancing to reach contention in the stretch but didn't do enough late. REIMA ROSE rated in striking position off the pace, lacked the needed late response. CLASSY FLOWER vied for the lead outside TUSCANY LIGHT into the stretch and tired.
