**Footnotes**

CAUGHTNTHEMOMENT set the pace along the inside, increased her advantage in midstretch, then was fully extended to prevail. FULFILLING chased the winner into the stretch but didn't do enough late. BEDDA VICTORIA reserved off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat but couldn't gain late. ELEGANT KINDNESS outrun after being steadied from tight quarters at the start, passed tired rivals. HOPESPRINGSETERNAL unhurried after being caught in tight at the start, improved her position in the drive without threatening. SAVING GRACIE steadied along the rail on the first turn, chased the pace into the far turn, then tired. SEAGRAVES well placed early, faltered on the far turn and was eased in the final eighth. RUN JAMAICAN'S RUN showed some early foot, faded and was eased in the stretch run. SIGNORINA SURVINA was outrun and eased leaving the far turn. MISS LUCY MAE tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, stopped and was eased in the stretch run.
