TOO MANY TOYZ tracked the pace, rallied three wide to take over at the quarter pole, then drew clear. NATHAN RIDGE reserved while saving ground, angled out for the stretch run and closed to prove second best. SEA MECKE stalked the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the quarter pole, then tired. MACHO GRANDE off slowly, was unhurried after being steadied in the early going, then improved his position in the drive. UNIQUE AFLEET raced four wide and failed to threaten. TARGE was not a factor. SEE I A set the pace along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. ANASHEED FLASH chased the pace into the far turn and faded. EXCALIBUR was through after a half mile.
