RACING APTITUDE was in contention and stalked the pace, went four wide in the final turn, made the lead and drew off. THE BEST GLACIER raced in the middle of the pack, made a steady advance, went four wide in the final turn and was just up for place. BLUE ANGEL EXPRESS was allowed to settle, went two wide in the final turn and was gaining on the leaders, just missed for place. PROFESSOR PALMER raced in the back of the pack, went six wide in the final turn and offered his best foot too late to catch the leaders. STOLEN POSSE raced in the back of the pack and rallied belatedly and was unable to catch the leaders. KRIS AND ME pressed the pace throughout and was used up in the mid stretch. QUICK CRICKET was outrun and passed tiring rivals. Z BREEZE set the pace and was eased in the late stretch run. VALTER showed brief speed and dropped back. DOUBLE DOWN BROWN pressed the early pace and steadily retreated.
