ASHLEE THE GREAT was in hand and went three wide in the final turn, rallied in the stretch and kept to task at the wire. MARILLA was void of early speed, circled the field eight wide in the final turn, loomed boldly on the leader but faded late. BOB'S JAWBREAKER was unhurried early, went three wide in the final turn and closed willingly. RAGE OF AQUARIUS made a steady advance, raced in close to the leaders and fanned six wide in the final turn, gave way in the late stretch. ASIATIC PEARL raced in the back of the pack, rallied belatedly and was unable to catch the leaders. JARDENIA raced even throughout. CUGATCHA was never far back from the front of the pack and weakened coming out of the final turn. INTENSE ELVIRA pressed the pace and faltered in the early stretch. METTLED set the pace and stopped in the final turn. LUNA CHARM raced close up to the leaders and was through after the half.
