ALINA ALINA chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the turn and was fully extended to hold LOTS OF TALENT safe. The latter, off slowly, moved up to chase the pace three wide and proved second best while gaining some ground on the winner late. REBECCA'S CHARM rated off the pace, advanced along the inside to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. STARSHIP GARNET unhurried early, improved her position without threatening. MOOCHIE TOO raced three wide around the turn and lacked a rally. PHAEDRA broke awkwardly bumping with ZOOBIE, then was not a factor. QUICK BIRD was outrun after breaking poorly. ZOOBIE bumped at the start, showed early foot, raced four wide around the turn and faltered. ROSES AND ROSES showed little. QUIET DINNER showed speed along the inside and faded.
