LITTLE MISS ECHO steadied when caught in tight along the rail racing down the backstretch, angled outside the leaders entering the stretch, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear. COOPER'S SONG well placed while saving ground, was blocked in the stretch to inside the eighth pole, altered course to the outside and finished willingly to be up for the place. QUICK FUSE chased the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command between horses in the stretch and tired. CHISPISKI showed speed, moved to the inside on the turn, continued on well to midstretch and gave way. AWOL rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the turn to reach even terms for command in the stretch, then faltered in the final eighth. JONI GALA was outrun. LINE OF FIRE trailed.
