HAPPY HARVEY tracked the pace, rallied four wide to gain command leaving the far turn, then drew away when roused and was taken in hand late. BLUE KING reserved off the pace after being caught in tight at the start, closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. IN HONOR OF HENRY chased the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, then gave way. CADET LOGAN chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. MY OMEGA RUN set the pace along the inside to past the quarter pole and faltered. TIZ TROUBLE raced four wide and faded. MISAEEL THE GREAT was done early after breaking awkwardly.
