Footnotes

JILLI'S DREAM set the pace under pressure, drew clear in midstretch and was all out to last over NO WINKING. The latter, bumped at the start, was blocked on the turn, split rivals in midstretch and closed well. SLICK'S DELIGHT, rated off the pace, outfinished the others. BILLS' KNIGHTMARE, outrun early, was bothered in midstretch when CHARGING DEE CEE drifted out, then improved position. CHARGING DEE CEE forced the pace along rail, then drifted out while tiring in the drive. LIVE PERFORMANCE, bumped at the start, was no threat while racing four wide on the turn. CORFU faltered. BEATIES FOR REAL chased the pace for a half mile and faltered.
