NAIGUATA reserved off the pace, swung wide for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole and drew away. PEPE'S VALENTINE showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. FROST WARNING rated off the pace after hitting the gate at the start, was saving ground when steadied in behind a wall of horses leaving the turn, made a run to loom a threat approaching the eighth pole but couldn't sustain her bid. POM POM POWER chased the pace four wide into the stretch and tired. JUST BLESSED pressed the pace outside PEPE'S VALENTINE, was put in tight by the loose horse at the quarter pole and faltered. ERICAFROMAMERICA was never a factor. CORYS DELIGHT ducked in at the gap leaving the chute unseating her rider. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE FALLEN RIDER.
