Footnotes

FLATTER THIS unhurried after breaking slowly, circled rivals four wide around the far turn, moved to catch HE'S SPECTACULAR inside the eighth pole, then edged away from that rival late. HE'S SPECTACULAR stalked the pace three wide, made a run to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, responded when challenged by FLATTER THIS, then weakened late. BROTHER PAT rated off the pace, rallied four wide to reach near even terms for command with HE'S SPECTACULAR approaching the quarter pole, then tried that rival to the eighth pole and gave way. RUNYON HUMOR stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then tired. INDIO ROOSTER failed to menace. POWER RULES was not a factor. SKY VENTURE set the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then faltered. CHISELED LIGHT was outrun. RIVERSRUNRYLEE chased the pace off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faded. FOGGY MOUNTAIN was stalking the pace three wide when he took a bad step on the backstretch and was pulled up.
