Footnotes

WHATA BRAINSTORM circled rivals five wide on the far turn, took over inside the eighth pole and edged away under steady urging. MUNTEJ (GB) unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. WOMBLE rallied on the far turn to reach contention, angled four wide to make his bid in early stretch, then flattened out. HAL'S HOPE set the pace along the hedge, continued on with good courage to deep stretch, then gave way. RUMSONONOTHERIVER saved ground into the stretch, angled out and lacked a late response. TOUR THE HIVE prompted the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command in midstretch, then weakened. MEGACLES chased the pace three wide to midstretch and tired. SUNSPOT reserved off the pace while saving ground, was blocked in the stretch and failed to threaten. LONELY PLACE (IRE) in tight at the start, was through after a half mile. THREE WONDERS well placed along the hedge, faltered leaving the far turn. IRISH WAYS (IRE) showed little. MR. BIGGLESWORTH steadied in traffic on the first turn and faded racing into the far turn.
