FIGHT OVER SEA rallied four wide to take over at the quarter pole, then drew away under urging. SEARCHFOR DIAMONDS rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed to prove second best. PENT UP FANTASY reserved early, raced five wide around the turn and gained the show. BLACK LACE chased the pace off the rail and tired. SAUCY VIXEN was not a factor. LADY CAPTAIN was outrun after breaking poorly. BOUNDING SMOOCHER showed little. MONUMENTHAL showed speed along the rail and faltered. SHOTS DOT showed early foot, raced three wide on the turn and faded.
