FAST JAK set the pace along the inside, responded when headed by QUIZ WHIZ on the backstretch, then drew away racing into the stretch and remained well clear to the wire under steady urging. UNO AGAIN reserved while saving ground, eased out in the stretch and closed with a mild rally to gain the place. MAJESTIC EXPRESS tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. THE WACO KID stalked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. QUIZ WHIZ chased the pace, made a run to gain a brief lead nearing the end of the backstretch, continued to try FAST JAK to midway of the far turn, then faded.
