TRUST THE DEPUTY stalked the pace along the inside, came around TRULY DISTINCTIVE leaving the far turn, then rallied along the rail to be just up at the wire. THE BEST GLACIER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to take over in the stretch, then just failed to last. BINGO BANGO BONGO reserved off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention but didn't do enough late. POWER RULES allowed to settle after breaking slowly, advanced to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. ANDERSONSTATE stalked the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace off the rail into the stretch, then tired. TRULY DISTINCTIVE set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then was fading when steadied at the eighth pole. REFLECTED CAT was through after a half mile.
