STOICO allowed to settle, raced three wide on the far turn, angled out wider for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be just up at the wire. PROUD DILIGENCE tracked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside PAUL B. JONES to take over at the eighth pole, then drifted out late under left handed urging and just failed to last. HO HO HO reserved early, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and rallied to gain the show. KING CASSIA rated off the pace, closed with a mild response. GO DIRECTLYTO JAIL chased the pace, made a run to loom a threat nearing the eighth pole, then weakened. BRIDE'S BEST BOY outran early, finished willingly without threatening. BOGANGLES off slowly, was unhurried early, advanced into contention four wide around the far turn but had no late response. PAUL B. JONES sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the stretch, then gave way. CHAMPAGNE BRUNCH well placed racing off the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. DANCING IN GERARDA showed early foot and faltered.
