CURRENT RUCKUS set the pressured pace, saved ground in the final turn, drew off and kept to task in the stretch run. DANCE PAL was unhurried early, was in the second path in the final turn and gave a mild rally in the stretch run. ULTERIOR MOTIVE went four wide in the final turn was even throughout race. GUIDING SPIRIT raced in the middle of the pack through the half, went four wide in the final turn improved his position in the stretch and flattened out. TASSO'S AFFAIR was pinched back at the start and lacked a late response. QUEEN'S KNIGHT failed to menace. SUNOFAMACHO was a step slow from the gate and failed to sustain bid. SALVATOR WONDER was in contention early and faded. BALLY DUFF BRIDGE was a step slow from the gate and was no threat. MOM'S WILDCAT broke slow from the gate and was no factor.
