Footnotes

CROWD PLEASER angled to the outside after entering the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn to gain command in early stretch and proved best under pressure. STAY SOUND, unhurried after being bumped at the start, advanced four wide on the far turn, then rallied in the drive to gain the place. THE KAISER, well placed, moved to the leaders on the far turn between horses, then continued on with good courage while being outfinished by the top ones. SKI MAKER stalked the pace and lacked the needed late response. SHAMROCK CITY set the pace along the hedge around the far turn and tired. JUDITH'S TEMPER stalked the early pace, gained a slim lead on the far turn but had nothing left for the drive. UP FRONT, steadied early, rated in midpack and lacked a rally. CRAFTY SANDI, steadied early, then failed to menace. SIGN OF A BIRD was no factor and returned sore. FONTEVRAULT, bumped at the start, checked racing into the first turn, advanced while saving ground into the far turn, then faltered.
