MISS DYNA rated off the pace, rallied three wide to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then was fully extended to prevail. TUFF MUFFIN unhurried early, was advancing along the outside when she bumped with FRANKLY MY SCARLET entering the far turn, continued to rally four wide to reach MISS DYNA leaving the far turn and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. TRIUMPH ARCH allowed to settle, improved her position in the drive to be up for the show. SAINTLY SUE unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals. CANT SMOKE ME stalked the pace into the far turn, then tired. THAT'S REAL NICE outrun early, swung out for the drive and failed to threaten. STEALTH HERSELF steadied in behind ATLANTIC SWEEP leaving the first turn, chased that rival along the rail, slipped through to gain the lead racing into the far turn, then gave way in the drive. FRANKLY MY SCARLET reserved off the pace, bumped with TUFF MUFFIN and steadied entering the far turn, then faltered. TUTTLE CREEK raced in striking position into the far turn and faded. ATLANTIC SWEEP set the pace off the rail to nearing the far turn and stopped.
