Footnotes

HIGH CEILING stalked the pace, wrested command before seven furlongs, resisted Saratoga Matt through the stretch then edged well clear despite drifting sharply near the end. SARATOGA MATT was pinched back to last after the start, angled wide while advancing on the opening turn, engaged the leader after six furlongs then faltered through the final sixteenth while also drifting at the end. SERAPI CAT angled four wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly without menacing the top pair. ROBYN CHIEF passed tired rivals. SOMES SOUND was shuffled back along the inside in the run down the backstretch then finished evenly. OFFICER'SGENTLEMAN was checked back to last along the inside after the opening half mile, struck the inner rail into the far turn, clipped heels of Somes Sound and stumbled approaching the stretch and was not a factor. SHANCLIF prompted the early pace and was done after six furlongs. KID CAROUSEL showed the way for six furlongs and dropped back suddenly once relinquishing the lead.
