**Footnotes**

BELLA BELLA showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew off under a vigorous hand ride. BLUSHING TIGER unhurried early, saved ground and closed to gain the place while no threat to the winner. LOLA'S RIDGE well placed after breaking a step slowly, couldn't keep pace with the winner and was outfinished for the place. SUNRISE CRUISE chased the pace three wide around the turn and gave way. SEA BIRDIE outrun after being caught in tight at the start, improved her position in the drive. GOING ON AGAIN chased the pace along the inside to midway of the turn, then tired. STORMY DEEDS showed early foot, raced three wide on the turn and faltered. HAWAIIAN CRUISE chased the winner into the stretch, then had nothing left for the final eighth. ALS BIG GIRL rated off the pace, faded leaving the turn. HOLIDAY BLAZE was outrun while racing four wide. BACK TO REALITY raced five wide and was done early.
