Footnotes

A LITTLE OFF stalked the pace, angled four wide on the far turn, then rallied to catch STAGE TRIP inside the sixteenth pole and edged away. STAGE TRIP set the pace while well in hand along the inside into the stretch, responded when challenged by A LITTLE OFF but couldn't stay with that rival late. MISS DAYNA LEE rated off the pace, came around PERFECT BERRY leaving the far turn, then rallied along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't gain late. PERFECT BERRY stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. FORBIDDEN BREW advanced three wide down the backstretch to chase the pace into the stretch, then faltered. COURTNEY RYAN moved up on the backstretch to prompt the pace outside STAGE TRIP into the stretch and faded.
