PICO BOLIVAR chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over soon after entering the far turn, made the pace into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. BAD NEWS CAPTAIN bumped with JOHNNY'S GALAXY at the start, was saving ground when steadied on the first turn, continued to save ground, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up for the place. TITLE TOWN stumbled at the start, moved up quickly to set the pace along the rail, was outmoued by PICO BOLIVAR on the far turn but continued on with good courage while just being edged to the wire for the place. ALWAYSONTHEGOJOE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. JOHNNY'S GALAXY reserved off the pace after bumping with BAD NEWS CAPTAIN at the start, failed to menace. WHY PHIL never threatened after being outrun early. OUR REDEMPTION tracked the leaders along the inside into the far turn, then tired. BEST TRIP raced three wide and faltered.
