THE WACO KID stalked the pace three wide, made a run to engage OUR CHAMPION midway of the far turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and edged away. OUR CHAMPION vied for the lead along the rail with ROAD TO BABYLON, responded when challenged by THE WACO KID on the far turn, then dueled with that rival and yielded in the final strides. RATTLESNAKE RED moved up down the backstretch to stalk the leaders into the stretch but didn't do enough late. SARATOGA MATT reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and gained some ground without threatening. NAVY WINGS failed to menace. FATHER LUCEY was not a factor. GROVE HALL unhurried early, was saving ground while advancing when steadied on the far turn, then tired. ROAD TO BABYLON vied for the lead outside OUR CHAMPION into the far turn and faded.
