TALIA'S CHOICE vied for the lead outside SAGAMORE, drew clear on the turn while remaining off the rail but couldn't hold off the winner late while clearly best of the rest. EL AVIADOR reserved off the pace while saving ground, couldn't keep pace with the top ones while closing to be up for the show. SAGAMORE vied for the lead along the rail into the turn, then tired. PROFESSOR G. R. was outrun after lunging at the start. GRAYBULL allowed to settle, faltered leaving the turn.
