Footnotes

DREAM GLOW took over soon after the start, raced restrained up the backstretch, continued to show the way through the turn, steadily increased advantage through the stretch while being kept to task and drifting. MIA'S DOUBLE between foes into the first turn when in the second flight, saved some ground the middle half, could do little with the winner in the drive, clearly second best. BOSTONIAN CAT four wide into the first turn between rivals, continued off the inside and the pace, brushed, four wide second turn, long drive for the show. MOREDIAMONDSPLEASE closest to the winner, began to weaken in the second turn, outfinished for the show. CHEAP PERFUME six wide into the first turn, raced outside, lacked a response when asked in the drive. BRITISH QUEEN bobbled then steadied at the start to spot the field a few lengths, remained back, brushed, fanned 5w into the lane, no bid. PACK ATTACK five wide into the first turn, was finished early, well beaten.
