Footnotes

SILVER DISTINCTION off a step slow, raced well back for five furlongs, asked along in the three path far turn, roused when straightened for home, finished with good late energy to be in time while remaining out in the strip. FEAR THE HEAT pressured the early leader off the inside, alternated for the advantage in the run up the backstretch, shook off the other speed to be clear in the second turn, larger lead midstretch, could not contain the winner while inside that rival at the wire. SINGING MY WAY in the second flight off the inside, moved closer outside with a half mile remaining, lacked a further response in the drive while prevailing for the show. IMPERIAL ROBYN broke on top, set the pace through the first turn, dueled in the run up the backstretch while closest to the inside, began to weaken in the second turn. SARAVA'S DANCER settled off the early pace, called on for some run late backstretch while between rivals, began to weaken in the second turn and had nothing for the drive. RINUNCIO BOBO fell back to trail throughout in a dull effort.
