PEDRO DEL VALLE rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied under pressure and wore down WISE DEVIL late to prevail. The latter, steadied in behind the leader on the first turn, stalked the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, maintained that advantage to deep stretch and yielded. SOLICITATION set the pace along the hedge, responded when headed by WISE DEVIL on the far turn, stayed with that rival to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. EL TUSCANO reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed with a mild response. JIM N JOHN outrun after breaking poorly, gained some ground without threatening. CATDUEL steadied soon after entering the first turn and was not a factor. ALBERT chased the pace to midway of the far turn, then tired. NO CALCETINES stalked the pace along the hedge, then was steadied when unable to get through inside SOLICITATION entering the far turn and faltered.
