SUPER BARBARA showed speed outside NAUTICAL BUT NICE into the turn, then drew off under urging. ADVANCED NOTICE outrun early, rallied along the rail to be up for the place while no threat to the winner. NAUTICAL BUT NICE pressed the pace along the inside into the turn, chased the winner into the stretch and weakened. DAD'S LOVE chased the pace four wide around the turn and gave way. BLUE FLARE chased the pace between horses into the stretch and tired. MISTI LIGHT chased the leaders three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. SHE SAID YES was outrun. DENIMSANDDIAMONDS raced five wide around the turn and faded.
