PEARLICIOUS settled off the pace while saving ground through the first turn, moved out after a half, ranged up to challenge second turn, took over, slight brush, got clear then was fully extended to just last. COFFEE RUN lacked speed off the inside, began to advance after four furlongs while remaining outside, three wide into the lane, set down, finished willingly to narrowly miss. SWEET ARGUMENT closest to the leader, moved up to challenge that foe from the outside as the winner was also challenging, brushed with the latter, could not keep up nor could she provide much resistance to the runner up, saved the show. SWEET N NUTTY last to leave, continued to race back, three wide into the lane, lodged a mild rally while not proving to be a serious threat. PUT IT ON A JET within striking distance for five furlongs, came up empty for the drive. FOR TERINA was never involved. SUPER GIRLIE got clear early, set the pace for over five furlongs, gave way when headed late in the final turn.
