CHRISTOPHER'SIMAGE four wide into the first turn when off the pace, continued outside, raced four wide through the second bend as well when beginning to advance, challenged with a furlong remaining, spirited battle to the wire to prove best in a determined effort. CLOSING MAN behind the pace along the inside, closer in the second turn, boxed in, moved out, between foes stretch, not enough for the win final strides, narrowly gained the place. JAKE CONRAD S broke well, got to the inside, set the pace along the inside, asked along late in the second turn, responded when challenged when straightened for home, gave ground grudgingly. EL COBRE broke with the field, rated off the pace, saved all the ground, angled out upper stretch, finished up evenly. PHIL'S FIRST fell back after the start, came five wide out of the final turn, managed a modest improvement while not posing a serious threat. ALISA'S ENGINEER within striking distance, gave way turning for home. TOTAL REWARD was never involved. OMEGA RISING closest to the leader for six furlongs, stopped in the drive.
