Footnotes

STARSHIP VENUS unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn, angled to the inside in the stretch, then rallied under a strong hand ride to take over at the sixteenth pole and edged away. SING ME A LULLABY reserved racing along the hedge, angled four wide on the far turn for racing room, then rallied for the place. COME SEE COME SA allowed to settle, rushed up along the outside to gain the lead entering the far turn, eased in to make the pace off the hedge to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. RED LACE chased the pace off the rail to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. MERCURY MOON tracked the pace three wide into the stretch but had no response when asked. MISSEQUINS rated off the pace, advanced racing into the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. ILL CONSIDERED chased the pace, moved to gain a brief lead racing down the backstretch, remained in contention into the stretch, then faltered. TRIPPI'S VALENTINE set the pace along the hedge for nearly a half mile, then faded. RACHEL'S GIRL was no factor and her rider lost his whip on the far turn. CACHUCHA trailed.
