FAN BASE broke awkwardly, moved up quickly to set the pace along the hedge, repulsed bids from ALL KNIGHT and AMERICAN DOE on the far turn, then was fully extended to prevail. ALL KNIGHT rated off pace, advanced three wide down the backstretch, made a run at the lead midway of the far turn but couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. SCOTTISH COAST unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied to be just up for the show. MIDNIGHT SERENADE outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed ground late to just miss the show. NIAM'S STRIKE reserved off the pace, gained some ground without really threatening. AMERICAN DOE chased the pace, made a run to try FAN BASE around the far turn, then weakened in the drive. HARRISON BAY well placed while saving ground, tired in the drive. BALTIMORE SAINT was not a factor.
