Footnotes

WIZARD'S GLASS rated off the pace, checked when caught in traffic on the far turn, angled out and rallied to gain the lead in early stretch, then drew away. TACTICAL GO GO outrun early, rallied to prove best of the rest while unable to stay with the winner. MISS MALAKIA unhurried early, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. LET'S GO OUT WEST reserved off the pace, rallied to gain the lead leaving the far turn, made the pace into the stretch and gave way. DOUBLE SHOW raced four wide and failed to menace. SCOTTISH LASSIE set the pace, drifted out racing down the backstretch, raced five wide on the far turn while continuing to make the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. QUAKER WAY was not a factor. MISTY FROLIC chased the pace for a half mile and faltered. HONKEYTONKVILLE chased the pace along the inside into the stretch, then faded.
