FIT AND AWESOME stalked the early pace from the outside, moved up to vie with three furlongs to run, put a head in front late in the turn, drew out in the drive under steady handling. KITTEN'S CAREGIVER lacked speed, raced in the three path into the turn, swung out to be five wide for the drive, improved but proved no match for the winner late. OLD PARR settled off the pace and the inside, roused three wide for the drive, displayed a modest amount of late interest to be up for the show. TIZANGELO narrowly set the pace along the inside, vied through the turn, weakened in the drive. MOTIN fell back to trail soon after the start, passed a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. DIXIE SLAM last away, moved up a few positions, tired while out in the strip. ROCK GOD vied early, between foes in the turn, stopped.
