BOLD PIC set the pace and increased his margin to the wire under a hand ride. STONE BRIDGE chased the pace outside but was no match for the winner. HAPPY PROSPECTOR chased the pace and tired. BURGER DAY, unhurried early, passed tired rivals. STORM ON HIGH, well placed early, faltered. TOM'S WIT, outrun early, improved his position. GO NANA GO was no factor after breaking slowly. COLD EXPRESS showed early foot along the rail and faded. FLYING SAND raced five wide on the turn and was not a factor. GAVIN was outrun while six wide around the turn. AESTHETIC showed little.
