Footnotes

A. J. MELINI stalked the pace, eased outside the leaders for the drive, rallied to gain command at the eighth pole, then drew off under urging. DASHING PIRATE pressed the pace outside DEISEL POWER, moved to gain a slim lead from that rival leaving the far turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then couldn't match strides with the winner while proving second best. DEISEL POWER set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then gave way. MINIDROP stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. HELLO MECKE saved ground and faltered. SUNSATONAL failed to menace. DAKOTA MAX was never a factor. FLINT MOUNTAIN off slowly, was outrun and pulled up in the stretch.
