Footnotes

NO ACT bumped, steadied soon after the start, fell back to trail out of the chute, steered out early in the turn, came four wide when advancing into the stretch, challenged with a furlong to run, all out late to narrowly prevail. ONESTEPTOGO outrun in the early going, came in the two path into the lane, dropped inside, challenged up the rail midstretch, raced on equal terms with the winner the final sixteenth while continuing along the inside to narrowly miss. CHARMED AFFAIR bumped with the winner early causing that foe to steady, raced within striking distance, challenged between the two leaders turning for home, vied past the furlong marker while continuing between to race between rivals, proved no match for the top two in the late going, saved the show. CARINA BAY broke sharp to show the way early, roused when garnering a slightly larger advantage midway on the turn, vied closest to the inside entering the stretch, allowed the runner up the rail with a furlong to run, weakened. PURELY PRECIOUS moved up to pressure the pace from the outside backstretch, three wide out of the turn, had little left the final furlong. BROWN FEATHER made little impact while racing just off the inside. MR. FOXY was outrun while racing wide most of the way. EXUBERANT SONG steadily faded off the inside.
