**Footnotes**

COUNTY GUN moved up to narrowly show the way early, dueled through the turn, kicked well clear in the drive under steady handling. DOUBLE JUDGE away best of all, relinquished the early advantage to the winner while well out in the strip, dueled with that rival through the turn, no match in the drive, held sway late for the place. CUNAGUARO devoid of early early foot just off the inside, split foes in the two path exiting the turn, finished willingly late to be getting to the runner up in the final strides. LONGER TERMS DOUG off the pace and the inside, was closest to the top two entering the stretch while in the three path, remained outside, was also gaining on the runner up late but was outkicked for the show. ZUBER lacked a closing bid while racing three wide. NEMO LANDING four wide for a half, bit wide for the drive, had nothing left the final furlong. GREAT VICTORIAN closest to the two leaders early, began a steady retreat before a half.
