Footnotes

PALZEE WALZEE settled off the pace about the three path, moved toward contention through the final turn, eased five wide into the lane and endured a long drive to get up the final yards. ROSSI'S GIRL rated off the pace inside, moved to even terms four wide near the quarter pole, dueled with the advantage from the top of the stretch, was clear a furlong out and dug in gamely to retain place while outfinished for the win. PRIMORDIAL THUNDER rated the pace inside the opening half mile, lost momentum at the heels of Kissinacop nearing the final turn, lacked room into the stretch, eased out looking for an opening and finished well when clear. GIMMEAMINK settled off the pace off the rail, angled out making her bid leaving the final turn and was closing well extremely wide. FRENCH KISSIN settled off the pace inside, gave chase on the final turn and finished evenly. SYLVIA TWICE stalked the pace two deep, threatened for the lead near the quarter pole and dueled close in the upper stretch before weakening a furlong away. BRONX BABE saved ground off the pace and had no rally. JUST A DREAM saved ground though never factored. KISSINACOP stalked the early pace thee wide, moved to the lead past the five eighths pole, was pressured for more into the stretch but gave way from there. SISTER LIDO was slow to start and never factored.
