STARSHIP TITAN broke out, brushed with HOW ABOUT PEACE, straightened then was forwardly placed early along the inside, moved out midway on the turn, engaged the leader turning for home, floated out slightly by that foe upper stretch, drove clear, drifted out then in late while remaining clear, kept to task final strides. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE TRAINER OF HIGH RED STAR AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. HIGH RED STAR outrun in the early going, angled to the outside midway on the turn, advanced when asked in the three path into the lane, angled in as the winner was drifting out with a sixteenth remaining, altered course to the outside when that same foe drifted in late, finished well clear of the others. CAPITAL HALL encouraged to make the early advantage after the start, cleared toward the inside late backstretch, rated briefly through the turn, offered little resistance to the top two in the drive, remained clear of the others. HOW ABOUT PEACE squeezed back at the start, raced well back early as a result, saved ground into the stretch, made little impact in the drive. FOUR J BOYS broke in, brushed with HOW ABOUT PEACE helping put that one in tight, straightened to race within striking distance early, brushed when in a bit tight late backstretch, faded in the drive. MY HOT CHILI raced outside and toward the front, brushed with FOUR J BOYS with a half mile remaining, gave way soon after.
