**Footnotes**

IMPERIAL ROBYN stalked the pace in the three path under restraint, moved closer late in the final turn, engaged the leader upper straight, put a head in front and slowly increased advantage. WHISPER ONTHE WIND lacked speed for six furlongs while saving ground, briefly boxed then got through when an opening presented itself entering the stretch, angled out steadily and made a late run to finish willingly for the place. TOP DOG showed the way onto the main track and past the wire the first time, set a lively pace under slight restraint, gave ground grudgingly through the lane. CHIPTease closest to the leader under restraint, roused for the drive, angled out slightly, was getting to the runner up late while between foes but did not have enough for the show. HERE WE GO JOE settled off the pace toward the inside and in hand, moved out exiting the final turn putting STARSHIP SILVERADO in tight and then into DYNAMIC BOY, finished up evenly. DYNAMIC BOY off the pace and the inside, was bumped by STARSHIP SILVERADO after that one was but in tight turning for home, recovered then lacked a rally when called on. STARSHIP SILVERADO lacked speed, was put in tight by HERE WE GO JOE out of the final turn, bumped with DYNAMIC BOY then remained back to the wire. AMERICAN LEGEND lacked speed outside, was four wide when bothered slightly into the stretch, trailed home.
