HIT THE CYCLE away well, relinquished the early advantage soon after, went after the leader into the turn, got clear, maintained a comfortable advantage through the stretch while being kept to task. WIRE TRANZFER broke a bit to the outside to help squeeze EIGHT RIDERS back, settled in the second flight toward the rail, asked along in the turn, was not a serious threat to the winner in the late going, well clear of the rest. VANISHING BUCK fell back after the start along the inside, two path out of the turn, dropped back to the rail, along for the show late. CZECH MASTER sprinted clear soon after the start, headed into the turn while along the inside, steadily weakened in the drive. BLANDISHING broke in, fell back in lacking speed, raced outside, roused for the drive, improved position without posing a serious threat. HEY BRAYDEN in the second flight for a half on the outside, faltered in the drive. EIGHT RIDERS squeezed back at the start, outrun.
