WHERE'SMYNOTEBOOK raced with the pace three wide, moved to take over leaving the turn, then drew clear through the stretch under pressure. WICKED SWEET chased the pace three wide around the turn and closed to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner. REXSON'S TOUR unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and passed tired rivals to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. MOONLIT STAR showed speed along the inside to the top of the stretch, then tired. BACK TO REALITY showed speed off the rail into the turn and faltered. PERFECT LIE was not a factor. CARICATURIST off slowly, moved up to track the leaders along the rail around the turn and faded. UNITY CALLING was outrun. CAT BIN was done early.
