Footnotes

BAD DEBT reserved early, surrounded by rivals in the second turn, raced behind a wall of horses into the lane, carried out along with three others by a drifting PICOU while forging through a small opening late, brushed both sides, narrowly prevailed in a gutsy effort. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. SPEAK EASY GAL took command soon after the start, set a modest pace off the inside, allowed PICOU the hedge turning for home, dueled with that foe past the furlong marker, carried out by that same rival late, brushed with the winner final strides proved game until the end. ALLEY OOP OOP tracked the pace from the four path, continued to be four wide into the straight, attempted to keep the winner in tight quarters past the furlong marker, brushed with that rival while the entire first flight was being carried out by a drifting PICOU, narrowly missed the place position. PICOU settled off the pace, saved ground, got through along the hedge exiting the final turn, dueled with the runner up, drifted badly when switched to a left handed stick with less than a furlong remaining, outkicked to the wire. THE BEST GLACIER off the pace while saving ground, steadied in tight along the inside late backstretch, continued in even fashion into and through the lane after recovering, lacked a serious late kick. NINEINTHENINE bobbed slightly at the start, pressured the runner up from the outside, had little left for the drive. STAY RED lacked speed, five wide into the lane when moving a bit closer, lacked a closing kick. ROMAN TIGER bobbed, broke out, never a threat while racing in the back.
