MY PAL CHRISY off a step slow, raced back early, began a steady advance late on the backstretch, swept to the fore while four wide turning for home, kicked clear on her own courage upper stretch and increased that advantage after feeling the whip only once in the drive in a sharp effort. FLYING TRIP back off the pace off the inside, loomed a threat five wide and outside the winner turning for home, proved no match for that rival in the drive, fully extended to hold the place. SUCCESSFUL SONG behind the first flight, closer then challenged between rivals late in the final turn, also proved no match for the winner, outfinished by the runner up while inside that one at the wire. CALLMETHESQUEEZE void of speed while saving some ground, closer second turn, altered course to the outside nearing midstretch, modest close while well out in the strip at the wire. HOOH WHY made little impact while racing outside. COOL VIXEN vied early between rivals, got clear onto the backstretch, showed the way into and through most of the second turn, gave way entering the stretch when headed by the winner. DELRAY LADY early foot along the inside, faded. REDBUD ROAD vied up front early three wide, chased the leader up the backstretch and gave way.
