HERMANS HONOR quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail, then increased her margin in midstretch and maintained her advantage to the wire under a strong hand ride. SWIRLING stalked the winner into the stretch, then couldn't gain on that rival while continuing on with good courage to save the place. CHIT CHATTER tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch, then lacked the needed response while being edged for the place. MICHAEL'S QUEEN unhurried early, saved ground and passed tired rivals. JEBLETTE reserved racing along the inside, angled out on the far turn and failed to rally. MAN I LOVE CLARE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. LUCKY VALID failed to menace. DAVID'S DOLL outrun after hitting the gate at the start, raced five wide on the far turn and was not a factor. PARISIAN TRIP chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. WHAT A SWEEP raced four wide and was done early.
