Footnotes

REHOBOTH reserved off the pace, advanced into contention between rivals around the far turn, then rallied along the inside to be just up at the wire. DAZZLING DR. CEVIN chased the pace, moved to take over midway of the far turn, then just failed to last. SUMMER BOOK tracked the pace, made a run three wide to reach near even terms for command entering the far turn, was outmoved by DAZZLING DR. CEVIN, responded to pressure in the drive and was gaining slowly at the finish. BIG LOVER tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and finished willingly. SIR JACKIE allowed to settle, moved up a bit around the far turn but didn't do enough late. SUPERVISOR outrun early, gained some ground without threatening. HAL'S IMAGE showed early foot and faltered. TEXAS RED was outrun after being caught in tight at the start. TOO MANY TOYZ outran HAL'S IMAGE for the lead, made the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faded.
